As you may know, in July we look forward to welcoming Anjali Kanagaratnam as our new curate and below is a short note from Anjali introducing herself.

Dear members of the Bybrook Benefice,

I am looking forward to joining the ministry team after my ordination and in meeting you all in person. In the meantime, I just thought I'd briefly introduce myself to you all.

I am married to Neil (an engineer) and we live in Chippenham with our three children, Nithilan (17), Jeyan (15) and Aarani (10). I was born in Sri Lanka but moved to the UK with my family when I was 11 years following the outbreak of civil war. I studied English and Theology at university and then trained as an RE teacher and taught for a 8 years until I took a career break when I had my oldest son. Around this time, over 17 years ago, we moved to Chippenham and began worshipping at St Paul's, Chippenham.

Growing up in a Christian family, my faith has always been an important part of my life and I have always been involved in church life and ministry. I was licensed as a Lay Minister at St Paul's in 2007 and it was while I was discerning this call, that I also felt that God may be calling me to be ordained. It was a call that I reflected on over the next ten years which saw us a family facing much change as we lived in Thailand on two separate occasions. On returning to the UK, I started the selection process for ordination culminating in beginning my training at Trinity College Bristol in 2018.

In my spare time I like to read, bake, play the piano, travel, catch up with friends and chill out with Neil, the kids and Milo, our puppy.

I look forward to joining you all as we worship and journey together and share God's love and hope to those around us.

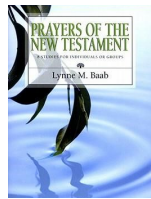
